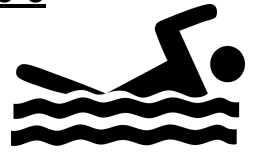
As we sneak through October, are you feeling like your child might benefit from some peer tutoring? Please contact [Mrs. Sheila Johnson](#) for more information.
