| GRADUATION CHECKLIST

- ❑ Students who have and are registered in sufficient credits for an Alberta High School Diploma.
- ❑ Students who have marks of 50% or better in all courses required for an Alberta High School Diploma on May 15th or on the first school day after May 15th.
- ❑ Students who have accounted for all fees and accounts at Hugh Sutherland School by May 15th.
- ❑ Enrolled at HSS within the current school year.

A preliminary list of grads who meet the above requirements will be posted June 1st.
A final grad list will be posted June 15th. Students who are not on the June 15th list will not be able to participate in the Cap and Gown Ceremony.
