- Key updates in policy, programing, communication
- Grade 10 internship April 24-26
 - Digital sign is ordered and will be installed summer 2024. 14'X7'. It will be hung on the south wall of east gym facing highway.
 - Digital streaming for school events is underway with portable camera purchased. We will be
 able to live stream any event in gym, outdoors etc. Ongoing streaming costs will be absorbed
 in student fees/sport fees.
 - Budget season for administration planning for next year.

 - Grade 10 internship April 24-26 student directed interest and placements being found.

 - Committees within school staff sit on a committee to work to see improvement in that area, many various ones but primarily wanted to discuss 2 today.
 - Facilities great improvements in first impression of our school to make it look more inviting/current - grad photos down except last 20 years (digital plan for all HSS photos); bulletin boards painted and cleaned up; new kodiak logos up, visitor couches outside office etc...
 - Kodiak Culture how do we build Kodiak culture? Looking at staff and student handbooks. Today brought 3 documents for parent input. Have already been brought to teaching staff. Dress code, Student code of conduct, Student expectations. Much valuable discussion around stating the 'why' then the rules are just that, the rules at HSS. The largest 'why' was in preparation for a professional, learning or work world expectations (eg hard hats, steel toed boots, professional attire etc; cell phone rules in various environments etc are expectations in the workforce). See admin if you want to see these working documents and have personal input. Teacher expectations is also a working document mentioned but not discussed today. Discussion that a parent expectations would also be valuable and truly a work that would help school council engage parents in good partnership with school community.
